Early Mortality Syndrome (EMS) or Hepatopancreatic Acute Necrosis Syndrome is a fairly new disease that affects shrimp. The disease was first seen in China in 2009, before it spread to Viet Nam in 2010, Malaysia and Northern Borneo in 2011 and Thailand in 2012. In 2013, EMS was reported for the first time outside Asia, showing up in Mexico - due to imports of infected live shrimps from Asia.

A recent disease of farmed Penaeid shrimp, commonly referred to as "early mortality syndrome" (EMS) or more technically known as "acute hepatopancreatic necrosis disease" (AHPND), was first reported in southern China in 2010 and subsequently in Vietnam, Thailand, and Malaysia [1]. The EMS/AHPND disease typically affects shrimp postlarvae within 20–30 days after stocking and frequently causes up to 100% mortality.

The early mortality syndrome (EMS) is an emerging shrimp disease more technically known as acute hepatopancreatic necrosis syndrome (AHPNS), caused by unique strain of *Vibrio parahaemolyticus*. The pathogenic bacteria colonize the shrimp gastrointestinal tract and produce a toxin that causes tissue destruction and dysfunction of the shrimp digestive organ (hepatopancrease).
