### Am I fit to fly? | UK Civil Aviation Authority

Before booking flights with Ryanair, expectant mothers need to keep in mind the following rules:. When an uncomplicated pregnancy enters in week 28, pregnant women are required to have written permission from a doctor/midwife. This form must be completed and dated two weeks before the scheduled flight departure.

Yes No. MEDICAL CERTIFICATE OF FITNESS TO FLY. This Medical Certificate must be completed in full, and produced at check-in and at each embarkation, by any passenger who has a medical impairment which may impact on his/her suitability to fly. Boarding may be denied if this form is not completed in full or at the sole discretion of a Rex agent or crew even when this form is produced.
