The color of a cable's outer sheath tells you the gauge of the wire inside the sheath as well as the amperage rating for the circuit. WHITE = 14-gauge wire, 15-amp circuit. YELLOW = 12-gauge wire, 20-amp circuit. ORANGE = 10-gauge wire, 30-amp circuit. BLACK = 8- or 6-gauge wire, 45- or 60-amp circuits.
