Ezra, another returning exile, returns with families into Jerusalem in 457 BC, and Nehemiah doesn't start building until 444 BC, according to this timeline from BibleHub. That means 13 ...

1. Ezra-Nehemiah builds our messianic hopes. Prophets spoke of how the restoration and transformation of Israel would happen through a Davidic king and the Holy Spirit. No matter how hard-working Ezra, Nehemiah, and others were, they couldn't circumcise people's hearts and cause obedience like the Spirit can.

When the enemies of God's people heard that the walls were being rebuilt and the breaches (openings) closed up, they were furious. So the enemies of God came "TO HINDER" (Nehemiah 4:8) the work of God. The builders of the wall could have easily stopped building and instead gone to fight the enemies of God's work; but they stayed the course.

Build While You Fight — Don't Stop Building for God!

Nehemiah teaches us that building something great for God requires 4 things: 1) Compelling Reason iV v4a iV look at the heart of Nehemiah here iV it;i's broken. Nehemiah is about to set out on a quest to rebuild and repopulate Jerusalem. He is going to leave the place where he is a slave and become a leader of his people.

Now imagine this: Jerusalem is in famine, Nehemiah decides to build the walls of Jerusalem again, so hundreds of people come from the countryside to help the man of God build the walls. There is already great pressure on the resources that are depleted in the city, and now all these - not illegal immigrants - but legal immigrants come.
