Sailboat Running Rigging Guide Sailboat running rigging is reasonably uncomplicated with headsails [being controlled by sheets] leading from the sail through adjustable fairleads to turning blocks and the winch. The positioning of the fairlead is significant to the performance of the sail, and is particularly so with roller reefing headsails.

Page 3 The vang system consists of two blocks and a line. The block with a shackle attaches to the eyestraps on the underside of the boom. The block with a v groove cleat and shackle attaches to the eye- strap on the mast. Lay out the block w/ shackle to the right of the block with vcleat, leaving about two feet between the two.
