Reader's Theater can be done in a traditional theater setting, but it can also be done almost anywhere there are listeners. Performing in hospitals or nursing homes offers great rewards. Often readings are recorded and then can be listened to by people in their cars, at home, or (with the advent of podcasting) on portable listening devices.

This is because the audio pickup, or reader, is set either above or below the lens assembly of the projector. Most analog pickups are in the basement (below the lens), while digital pickups are normally in the penthouse (fastened to the top of the projector). A test film is run to calibrate the sound to the picture.
