Qualitative Research Methods in Human Geography ... interview is one in which you have an idea about the types of questions you ask but the order and way you ask the question may vary. A structured interview is a specified set of questions that is asked in the same order using the same words during each interview.

Asking the questions in the same order is called scheduling. Interviews, however, can be non-scheduled, though still partly standardised. This is some-times called a semi-structured interview. Here, the interviewer

works from a list of topics that need to be covered with each respondent, but the order and exact wording of questions is not ...
